

**OUTSTANDING ALUMNI HUMAN SERVICES PRACTITIONER
NOMINATION & SELECTION INFORMATION**
New Category!

Nominations will be accepted from May 5 through June 19, 2015.

A Nominee must be:

- A graduate of the Curry School of Education
- Currently working as a practitioner in a human services field for which the Curry School offers or has offered a degree, including school counseling, mental health counseling, clinical and school psychology, speech pathology and audiology, athletic training, or sports medicine. (Alumni working as higher education faculty members in any of these fields are not eligible to be recognized in this category.)

Criteria for judging the nominees:

- Client Welfare: Promotes client welfare in ways that exceed expectations of his/her professional community.
- Professional Stature: Recognized as an outstanding professional beyond his/her immediate place of employment.
- Excellence in the profession: Demonstrated accomplishments in his/her professional community.
- Dedicated Service: Provides service to his/her community, outside of the work environment.

Information required to be submitted online:

- Completed online nomination form
- One formal letter of nomination (.doc, .docx, or .pdf formats accepted)
- Nominee's vita condensed to no more than 5 pages highlighting key accomplishments (.doc, .docx, or .pdf formats accepted)
- **No more than two one-page letters of support** from observers or beneficiaries of his/her professional services, including colleagues, work supervisors, or clients (.doc, .docx, or .pdf formats accepted)

Submitted documents should NOT include pictures, petitions or press releases

The Outstanding Human Services Practitioner Award is considered a lifetime achievement. Recipients are not eligible to receive the award more than once. This is a non-monetary award.
