

**OUTSTANDING ALUMNI MIDDLE SCHOOL TEACHER  
NOMINATION & SELECTION INFORMATION**

**Nominations will be accepted from May 5 through June 19, 2015.**

**A Nominee must:**

- Be a graduate of the Curry School of Education,
- Be an employed teacher in middle school grades in a public or private school, and
- Have successfully completed three years of teaching.

**Criteria for judging the nominees:**

- Excellence in Teaching - demonstrated outstanding accomplishment in his/her school.
- Professional Stature - recognized as an outstanding teacher beyond his/her school.
- Dedicated Service - provided service to his/her community, outside of school environment.
- Student Welfare - promoted general student welfare through working with student activities and organizations.

**Information required to be submitted online:**

- Completed online nomination form
- One formal letter of nomination (.doc, .docx, or .pdf formats accepted)
- Nominee's resume (no more than 5 pages) highlighting key accomplishments (.doc, .docx, or .pdf formats accepted)
- **No more than two one-page letters of support** for the nominee (.doc, .docx, or .pdf formats accepted)
  - Letters should include one school administrator, and other evidence of outstanding teaching.

Submitted documents should NOT include pictures, petitions or press releases.

The Outstanding Alumni Teacher Award is considered a lifetime achievement. Recipients are not eligible to receive the award more than once.

The Outstanding Alumni Teacher Award recipient will receive \$500 to be used for professional development purposes.
