

OUTSTANDING CURRY SCHOOL ALUMNI SUPERINTENDENT NOMINATION & SELECTION INFORMATION

Nominations will be accepted from May 5 through June 19, 2015.

A Nominee must be:

- A graduate of the Curry School of Education
- An employed superintendent in a private school or a public school system

Criteria for judging the nominees:

- Excellence in School Administration - demonstrated accomplishments in his/her school or school system
- Professional Stature - recognized beyond his/her own school
- Dedicated Service - provided service to his/her community

Information required to be submitted online:

- Completed online nomination form
- One formal letter of nomination (.doc, .docx, or .pdf formats accepted)
- Nominee's vita or resume condensed to no more than 5 pages highlighting key accomplishments (.doc, .docx, or .pdf formats accepted)
- **No more than two one-page letters of support** for the nominee (.doc, .docx, or .pdf formats accepted)

Submitted documents should NOT include pictures, petitions or press releases.

The Outstanding Superintendent Award is considered a lifetime achievement. Recipients are not eligible to receive the award more than once. This is a non-monetary award.
