

OUTSTANDING CURRY PROFESSOR NOMINATION & SELECTION INFORMATION

Nominations will be accepted through June 30, 2015.

A Nominee must be:

- A full-time member of the Curry School faculty

Criteria for judging the nominees:

- Teaching - dedicated to classroom teaching, field experiences, and individual study/research
- Student Welfare - devoted to promoting the general student welfare through working with student activities and organizations
- Career Development Activities - committed to helping students with professional activities and career opportunities
- Leadership - accomplished in the creation and dissemination of knowledge

Information required to be submitted online:

- Completed online nomination form
- One formal letter of nomination (.doc, .docx, or .pdf formats accepted)
- Nominee’s vita condensed to no more than 5 pages highlighting key accomplishments (.doc, .docx, or .pdf formats accepted)
- **No more than two one-page letters of support** From Curry faculty or other professionals (.doc, .docx, or .pdf formats accepted)

Submitted documents should NOT include pictures, petitions or press releases.

The Outstanding Curry Professor Award is considered a lifetime achievement. Recipients are not eligible to receive the award more than once. This is a non-monetary award.
